## Creating a safe environment

As we ready ourselves to open our gates and welcome people onto the land again, not so much has changed. We have systems in place, plenty of fresh air and a friendly and helpful team to help keep you safe and supported during your visit.

The Government COVID guidelines are hands, face, space, fresh air, so our protocol is as simple as that;

- test yourself before you arrive
- wash your hands often
- give each other space
- and because we have so much wonderful fresh air we do not require you to wear a mask.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the valley and wish you a relaxed and easeful stay.

## We are implementing the following measures to assure the health and safety of all participants:

- **24 hours prior to arrival all participants are asked to take a rapid lateral flow COVID test**, we reserve the right to ask someone not to attend if they are considered a risk to other participants.
- On arrival you are asked to scan in using our NHS COVID-19 tracking QR code. You can do this using the NHS COVID-19 app on your phone.
- We will be following government social distancing guidelines
- Adequate space is provided in the dining yurt and indoor spaces to enable social distancing.
- We will spend as much time as possible in outdoor spaces
- Hand sanitising stations will be available around the site to use as you move from one activity/venue to another.
- Overnight stays will be in single occupancy yurts or your own tent until social distancing is lifted
- Your travel to and from Embercombe will be your own responsibility.
- You should not join a course if you've had coronavirus symptoms in the last 2 weeks.
- Anyone who needs to cancel under these circumstances will be given credit for another course.
- We ask you to bring a mask with you in case it is necessary.
- If you fall ill during your stay we will ask that arrangements are made to return home and to enter self-isolation.

This information is subject to change. We are continually following Government guidelines to assess how we can safely deliver our programmes with ease and grace for all. If the situation changes and courses have to be cancelled we will refund or reschedule participants.
